developed the use of acting out roles and from this he got the idea of utilizing creativity, spontaneity, and catharsis in the treatment of emotional problems. He modelled it after life itself. Rather than having the person talk about life in a private corner of a room, he provided a stage area in which the person could enact his own life situations with the help of the group and the therapist-director.
