at all. The word 'politics' does not appear in the index, and neither does Marxism, terrorism, vandalism, Catholicism, democracy or feminism - though to be fair, there is one sentence where the word 'feminism' appears.

This is a nice book, and it contains a lot of interesting information, and it is not too expensive. I just wish it were a lot tougher.
